#### 7.1 Kathy Spate, Region 10 Director (if present)

Ms. Spate was not in attendance. Steve Reid provided flyers to the group regarding the CSBA Roadshow, which will be on October 17<sup>th</sup> from 6-8 p.m. at Fresno Unified School District. The next CSBA Conference will be held in San Francisco. Members were encouraged to attend.

#### 8.0 Introduction of Program

Dr. Massetti thanked Yosemite Unified School District for hosting the MCSBA dinner meeting and introduced the presenters. Jessica Fielding, Section Chief, Community Services Division/Program and Policy Section of California Department of Health Care Services and Jan Ryan, TTA Consultant presented, "What School Policy Makers Need to Know About Vaping, Marijuana, & Opioids." They noted the rate of vaping has sky rocketed. The program shared with the group has received three Golden Bell awards. The training is geared toward teachers, administrators, and staff who work with students.

Recent data shows suspensions and expulsions for illicit drugs are approximately 17% of the total suspensions and expulsions. In Madera, the numbers are higher. 27% of students are suspended for illicit drugs and 29% of students are expelled.

Evidenced based strategies include:

- Information dissemination that is youth led/driven
- Education provided through school counselors
- Alternatives, such as Friday night events
- Problem ID and referral (ex: administrator catches a student on campus)
- Community based processes additional funding is available for these
- Environmental

The recommendation is to incorporate solutions into Board policies so that they have lasting results. Ms. Ryan recommended the Brief Risk Reduction Interview and Intervention Model (BRRIMM), which has been awarded three Golden Bell awards. The models are personalized and the course is available online through Ventura County Office of Education at a minimal cost. The program is cost effective, centralized, and has a proven track record.

Ms. Fielding added a repository of programs will be available in about two years. She stated BRRIIM is best for use with junior high and high school students. She noted

vaping is incredibly addictive. Hash oil has been known to trigger schizophrenia. Social media products are being developed to help reduce vaping.

Shelley Johnson conducted the raffle and prizes were awarded. \$620 were raised for the scholarship fund.
